





# General production advice warepotatoes

#### version 2009 - 01

# Plant populations

Advice planting distance (row distance 75 cm.)

28/35 mm - ca. 51.000 pl./ha. Pl. distance  $\pm$  26 cm. 35/50 mm - ca. 47.500 pl./ha. Pl. distance  $\pm$  28 cm. 50/55 mm - ca. 44.500 pl./ha. Pl. distance  $\pm$  30 cm.

#### **Fertilizer**

Fertilisation more or less equal to Spunta. Advise Nitrogen fertilisation ca. 250 kg N/ha. including soil supply. A split application is advised, 2/3 at the beginning and 1/3 directly after tuber set.

Potassium and Phosphorus according to normal soil advice.

Organic fertilisers are not advised.





# General production advice warepotatoes

#### Pre-treatment and planting



- Dormancy is long with a strong apical sprout dominance.
- Take the seed out of store in good time . A heat treatment is desired to waken up all the sprouts.
- Don't plant in too cold soil. Fabula is little sensitive to Little Potato disorder.
- Plant a bit deeper than normal.
- The best results are achieved on lighter soils with a good soilstructure.

### **Growing attentionpoints**



- In the beginning development is a bit slow; later the foliage develops well.
- The colour of the leaf is rather lightgreen.
- Tuber number is low.
- Spraying against Late Blight (Phytophthora) is advised regularly and in good time .

#### Haulmkilling and harvest



- Before harvest the tubers must be hardened off. Harvest with care.
- Fabula is not so sensitive to bruising and mechanical damage.
- Limit dropping heights during harvest and storing.

# **Storage**



- Fabula is easy to store when taken care of a good woundhealing and drying of the product after harvest.
- Too much damage on the tubers and bad woundhealing can cause a strong dehydration of the tubers
- Ensure a rather low and constant storage temperature because the variety is rather sensitive to Silver Scurf.
